



COMMUNICATION

It is communicated to the public that in compliance with Supreme Decree No 4605 of October 27, 2021, for travelers coming from abroad to the Plurinational State of Bolivia, with mandatory nature the following measures are established:

a) In case of having a certificate of vaccination against COVID-19 with complete scheme with at least fourteen (14) days prior to the date of entry, perform the following:

1) **Certified negative** RT-PCR test for persons older than five (5) years of age:

i) Up to seventy-two (72) hours prior to their embarkation in the country of origin, for national or foreign persons coming from outside the country by air.

ii) Up to seventy-two (72) hours before entering the Plurinational State of Bolivia for nationals or foreigners entering the national territory by land, river or lake.

2) Before **entering the Bolivian territory**, foreign passengers who do not have permanent **residence in** Bolivia **must** have a health **insurance** with coverage for COVID-19, which covers the expenses for their treatment.

b) In case they do not have a **certificate of vaccination** against **COVID-19 with** complete vaccination schedule at least fourteen (14) days prior to the date of entry, the following must be done:

1) Comply with the measures indicated in paragraph a) in its totality.

2) Perform the RT-PCR test after seventy-two (72) hours of entry into Bolivian territory, the cost of which shall be covered by the passenger, and remain in mandatory **isolation from entry** until the negative result is obtained, which shall be controlled and monitored in accordance with current regulations of the Ministry of Health and Sports; in case of a positive result, the corresponding protocol shall be complied with.
